Agastache 'Blue Fortune'	Anise Hyssop	Sun	36" x 24"	24"	6	A compact form, 'Blue Fortune' was selected for its profusion of deep-blue flower spikes. A butterfly magnet, 'Blue Fortune' makes quite a statement with its compact habit and long lasting flowers.
Agastache foeniculum 'Golden Jubilee'	Anise Hyssop	Sun	20" x 15"	18"	4	A new hyssop that is creating quite a buzz in the gardening world primarily for its' chartruese to yellow foliage. 4" lavender-blue flower spikes are loved by butterflies and hummingbirds alike! Very heat tolerant.
Ajuga 'Black Scallop'	Carpetbugle	Shade	4" x 12"	12"	4	An excellent container and accent plant. Dark, glossy, scalloped foliage is accented by deep-blue flower spikes.
Ajuga x tenorii 'Chocolate Chip'	Carpet bugle	Shade	6" x 8"	8"	4	Narrow, shiny chocolate-brown foliage covers the ground like spilled fondue. The bluish-purple flowers are a welcome spring sight atop the sleek, low growing foliage. Perfect for shade borders and shade container combinations.

Anacyclus Depressus	Mount Atlas Daisy	Sun	4" x 12"	12"	4	Gray-green foliage covered with white daisy-like flowers with purplish-red undersides. Anacyclus is a most desirable plant for rock gardens or raised beds, where the attractive crimson buds can be seen in cloudy weather or poor light!
Anemone sylvestris	Windflower	Shade	12" x 12"	12"	4	White, 2", fragrant flowers form in the spring. Foliage is deeply lobed and medium green. May repeat bloom in the cool weather of early autumn. An excellent addition to woodland gardens or naturalized areas.
Antennaria dioica 'Rubra'	Common Pussytoes	Sun	10" x 12"	12"	4	Lacey mats of silvery foliage are topped with rosy-red, fuzzy flowers that resemble the toes of your favorite pussy cat. Use in borders or as a lovely accent in containers.
Aquilegia x caerulea 'Origami Blue and White'	Columbine	Sun	18" x 15"	12"	4	Color splashes about when these Columbines spring into buds and bloom. Truly a break through in breeding! Aquilegias that are free-flowering, and uniform in height.

Astilbe japonica 'Peach Blossom'	False Spirea	Shade	24" x 18"	24"	4	Airy plumes of peach with a hint of pink bloom above lacy, fern-like foliage. A perfect selection for adding contrast against darker foliaged plants or as an accent to other Astilbes. Hummingbirds love it! Luscious and lightly fragrant.
Astilbe x arendsii 'Bridal Veil'	False Spirea	Shade	24" x 24"	24"	4	An early-blooming Astilbe with gracefully arching feathery white plumes. A perfect selection for adding contrast against darker foliaged plants or as an accent to other Astilbes in the woodland garden. Hummingbirds love it! A classic beauty!
Astilbe x arendsii 'Fanal'	Fanal False Spirea	Shade	15" x 18"	24"	4	Dark red, feathery flower plumes compliment the cut-leaved foliage of 'Fanal'. Creates a fuller, more delicate appearance to an all time favorite, with heavily crested fronds. The best color on new fronds is developed on ferns in light shade.
Athyrium x 'Branford Beauty'	Branford Beauty Fern	Shade	12" x 18"	18"	4	A perfect cross between Lady Fern and Japanese Painted Fern! 'Branford Beauty' offers the striking colors of Japanese Painted Fern, showy red stems, and an upright habit of Lady Fern to complete the package.

Bergenia cordifolia 'Winterglut'	Pig Squeak	Sun	12" x 15"	12"	5	Leathery, evergreen leaves are waxy & thick, turning a deep burgundy at the onset of winter. Panicles of pink flowers stand just above the foliage in early spring. A true treasure of gardening, plant in groupings for the best effect.
Bletilla striata	Asian Ground Orchid	Shade	8" x 12"	12"	5	Purple miniature butterfly-like flowers hover above pleated foliage. Few plants in the orchid family are suitable for the outdoor garden, yet this one is reliable and vigorous.

Campanula garganica 'Dickson's Gold'	Bellflower	Sun	4" x 12"	12"	5	Bright gold spring foliage with bright blue, starry-shaped flowers. Chosen as a 2003 Great Plant Picks, this low, creeping perennial will be your pick for adding glowing color to rock gardens or borders. Blooms in early summer.
Campanula poscharskyana 'Blue Waterfall' PP#13,161	Bellflower	Sun	6" x 12"	12"	3	Profusion of violet-blue bell-shaped flowers that "flow" from the center of the plant. A Blooms of Bressingham introduction, this low-growing, vigorous spreading plant is perfect for the front of borders, rock gardens and trailing over walls.
Campanula takesimana 'Elizabeth'	Bellflower	Sun	18" x 18"	15"	5	A real performer, 'Elizabeth' boasts large, maroon and pink pendulous bells on erect stems all summer. A good Campanula for the heat!

The fine-textured foliage of 'Evergold' lends itself to the formal border, for brightening up a semi-shady area of the garden, and adding year-round stunning color.
Carex morrowii 'Ice Dance'	Variegated Sedge	Shade	12" x 12"	12"	5	Narrow green leaves with creamy-white margins form bright masses of arching foliage add texture and light to a shade garden, or mixed container. At its' best when planted in moist shade with Heuchera or Hosta.
Carex testacea	Orange Sedge	Shade	15" x 12"	12"	5	The copper color of this fine-textured, gracefully arching foliage is quite unique. Orange-colored sedge makes a unique accent plant in mixed borders. Its long, narrow leaves are also beautiful cascading over containers.

Delosperma 'Kelaidis' PP#13,876	Mesa Verde Ice Plant	Sun	4" x 12"	12"	4	Iridescent salmon-pink blooms blanket the sunny garden from spring to frost! A great groundcover for sunny beds or borders, this easy-to-grow variety puts up with just about everything. Asexual propagation prohibited.
Delphinium grandiflorum 'Blue Mirror'	Blue Mirror Delphinium	Sun	18" x 15"	15"	3	Compact spikes of deep blue color fill the middle border for spring. This compact form of delphinium has deep shiny blue flowers. It can be used in container plantings for that vertical, eye catching element.
Dendranthemum rubellum 'Clara Curtis'	Mum	Sun	24" x 18"	18"	4	An old time favorite, 'Clara Curtis' has the feel of an old fashioned garden mum on dwarfed foliage. Long grown for its ability to flower on stems around 24" in height, 'Clara Curtis' is an excellent late summer, pink garden mum.
Dianthus 'Frosty Fire'	Double Red Flowering Dianthus	Sun	10" x 12"	12"	4	Double-red flowers adorn blue-green tufts of foliage all season. Makes a brilliant showing in rock gardens, edgings, mixed containers or as a ground cover.

Dicentra spectabilis	Bleeding Heart	Shade	12" x 12"	12"	3	Heart-shaped, dangling rose-pink flowers with white tips beneath arching stems. A charming garden classic that adds remarkable beauty and grace when planted under trees, in woodland gardens or naturalized areas. Blooms in spring.
Dicentra x 'Luxuriant'	Bleeding Heart	Shade	12" x 12"	12"	3	Cherry-red flowers dangle above fine-textured foliage, lending beauty to a shady site. Lovely, heart-shaped flowers attract hummingbirds to the garden from late spring to fall.
Digitalis x 'Camelot'™	Foxglove	Sun	36" x 36"	36"	4	Few plants rival the spires of Foxglove for adding stately elegance to beds or back of borders, as well as being a perfect cut flower for indoor enjoyment. Bright, cream-colored blooms with a speckled throat. Loved by hummingbirds!
Dracocephalum ruyschianum 'Blue Dragon'	Dragon Head	Sun	15" x 18"	18"	4	A lover of dry, well-drained soils with the look and feel of a soft rosemary! Dark-blue dragon-head flowers cover a low thick mound of fine rosemary-like foliage in early summer. Very easy to grow and reliably hardy.
Dryopteris erythrosora 'Brilliance'	Brilliance Autumn Fern	Shade	24" x 24"	24"	5	'Brilliance' is a selected form of Autumn Fern with new growth of an especially vivid shade of scarlet. If the lovely colors weren't enough, this Fern is very hardy, tolerating even drought!
Echeveria 'Black Prince'	Hens & Chicks	Sun	6" x 8"	12"	8	One of the darkest of the Echeverias, 'Black Prince' will tolerate a wide range of conditions including a hard frost. Forms solitary rosettes with few off-sets. Makes an interesting focal point in dry gardens.

Echinacea purpurea 'White Swan'	White Coneflower	Sun	24" x 24"	24"	4	Echinacea is one of the many plants in the coneflower group with strong, erect stems, and flower petals that radiate from a central purple cone. Differing from the rose pink selections, 'White Swan' is a white flowered form, with drooping petals.
Euphorbia 'First Blush'	Cushion Spurge	Sun	12" x 15"	15"	4	Foliage emerges pale green with creamy margins in early spring. Rosy buds surrounded by showy, golden bracts appear next before the pale pink flowers open. Prune to 4" above the ground after the blooms are spent to encourage lush regrowth and more blooms.
Euphorbia 'Kalipso'	Cushion Spurge	Sun	8" x 18"	18"	5	Yellow and green flowers appear above globes of moss green foliage in spring. Evergreen foliage looks wonderful in both a planter and landscape setting!
Festuca ovina glauca 'Elijah Blue'	Blue Fescue	Sun	6" x 8"	8"	4	Fine textured blue clumps are perfect partners for spring flowering bulbs. This blue, clumping grass looks dynamite when planted in masses or tucked in containers. Use the fine texture to soften the edges of pots.
Gaillardia x grandiflora 'Fanfare'	Blanket Flower	Sun	18" x 18"	18"	3	A drought tolerant perennial known for a huge color display in early summer. Blanket Flower is valued for its mid-summer flowers in a range of hot colors from deep yellows to burgundies. A salt tolerant plant for sunny locations.
Gaillardia x aristata 'Bijou'	Blanket Flower	Sun	8" x 12"	12"	3	Much more compact than the species, 'Bijou' is a dwarf seed strain that produces deep-purple leaves and 3" orange-red flowers that are tipped with yellow. A butterfly magnet!
Galium odoratum	Sweet Woodruff	Shade	8" x 12"	12"	4	White, fragrant flowers give the appearance of newly fallen snow in the spring. A popular, useful ground cover. Sweet Woodruff quickly covers large areas with a sufficient supply of water.

Geranium 'Bertie Crug'	Hardy Geranium	Sun	4" x 12"	12"	5	Dainty cherry-pink flowers rest atop chocolate-green foliage. The seemingly endless flower display and glossy leaves add color and texture to the front of borders all year long. Cascades nicely over a wall or along a garden path.
Geranium 'Johnson's Blue'	Hardy Geranium	Sun	15" x 12"	12"	4	A longtime favorite with periwinkle-blue flowers set against finely cut foliage! A true-blue color for informal borders, along walkways or in mass plantings. A good butterfly attractor, and a great plant for beginning gardeners.
Geranium sanguinum 'Striatum'	Bloody Cranes Bill	Sun	6-8" x 12"	12"	4	Shell-pink flowers seem to float around the green rosette like butterflies to nectar. The foliage, green with crimson veins, is the perfect backdrop for the shell-pink flowers. Compact growth lends itself to many uses in borders and containers.
Geranium x cantabrigiense 'Biokova Karmina'	Cranes Bill	Sun	12" x 12"	12"	4	A lovely cerise-pink geranium looking great in rock garden settings. The aromatic deeply lobed, red-tinged foliage works well in full sun and some afternoon shade. Requires well drained soils.
Geum coccineum 'Cooky'	Geum	Sun	10" x 12"	12"	5	Dense cushions of shiny foliage give rise to stems of open-faced orange flowers. A cheerful variety perfect for the sunny garden border or planted among other brightly colored summer selections. Blooms over a long season.
Gypsophila 'Festival Star'	Baby's Breath	Sun	12" x 18"	18"	5	Good for dry, hot, alkaline soils, this everblooming dwarf Baby's Breath boasts the typical cloud-like spray of tiny white flowers.
